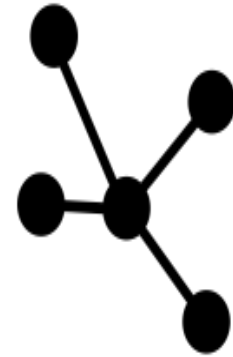

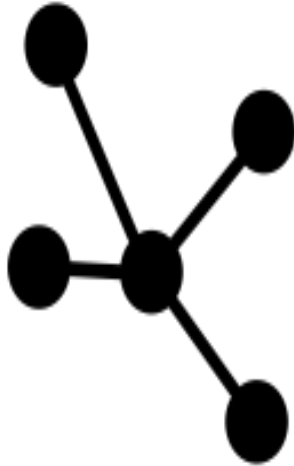
## **AERI over Ten Years: An Analysis**

- Funded by Society of American Archivists Foundation Grant

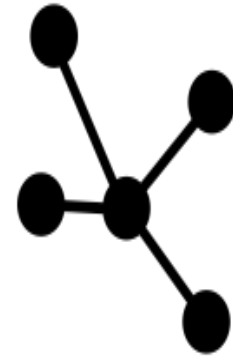


## DataONE Skillbuilding Hub
